Give chance to refugees - the project aims to prevent **the radicalization of young people**, as well as to promote and protect the rights of a vulnerable group of refugees and migrants, in particular the right to asylum and the right to personal liberty. Project combines education and direct legal aid, thus focusing on the prevention of discrimination, racism, and xenophobia among young people (in the form of interactive workshops on migration in primary and secondary schools with the participation of refugees, and lectures from Police Force).
